Complains of persistent headache and of pain in pelvic region - says she sees creeping things wriggling about at night - has had auditory hallucinations (ticks in ears). Says her family do not understand her. Slightly incoherent at times - Admits being tired of life but is not self accusing nor is she truly melancholic. Says she is run down. Is hypochondriacal. Says she has never been the same since she was under chloroform at 13 3/4 of age.

Physical condition on admission—

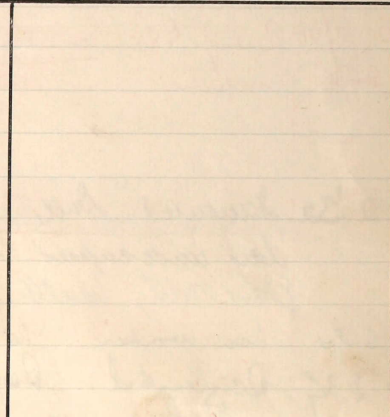
Is anaemic - dark complexioned - overgrowth of hair on lips & chin - Heart's action slow - but sounds are clear - lungs appear normal.

21. 3. 09 Has had Thyroid for ten days, 60 grs the last 4 days. She has had a temperature of 99.6° in the morning & 100.6 at night. She has eaten well & seems very well in her bodily condition.
